**6. Extra Activity During the Convention:**

An extraordinary (first time) 'WALK FOR CHRIST' of members was undertaken on Saturday, January 29, 2022, with banners and singing groups started from the Sanniquellie Saclepa parking in Gompa City, to LICC Main Campus. It was very exciting and worth thanking God for, especially, with the older folks taking part. At the end of 'WALK FOR CHRIST', short words of exhortation and praises were given by ULIC – National President and Chairman of the walk. Little over twelve thousand (\$12,000.00) Liberian Dollars got collected.

**7. Reports given during the Business Meeting (from):**

**8. Key items captured from the Business Meeting:**

A comprehensive financial report on the twenty percent (20%) received from ULIC -Regions was given by Bro. F. Takpor Zekpeh, the Financial Secretary and/or acting National Treasurer.

9. Amazingly, and to the glory of God, reports of 'New Churches' were given ..... Zwedru, Greenville, Guinea and Bo/Sierra Leone are the areas reported on.
10. New ULIC - Region formed:  
After a lengthy discussion during our last Administrative Meeting in December, 2021, a letter from six Churches within Buutuo Region stated their desire of forming a separate region. This was accepted and approved in our last Business Meeting during the convention. The name of the new region is called '**DINPLAY**'.
11. Evangelist/Rev. Prince D.Z. Kpewoan, National General Secretary, was reelected for another five-year term.
12. New Chairperson of ULIC - School/Board is to be elected.
13. ULIC ID Cards: Signing starts with the National President and ends with local pastors.
14. Clarification made: The deed of LICC is in the name of the Church-United Liberia Inland Church.
15. Elections of Women's Leaders: Elections of leaders for the National Women will be done this year, in March, during their conference in Johnsonville.
16. Even though elected as head of the National Youth, Pastor Alex Tomah will be Ordained next week before his ordination in March, 2022
17. Explanation of the 40% paid by regions made by the President: 20% National Headquarters, 10% / Regional Office & 10% Education.
18. Note: Arrears owed the National Headquarters of ULIC \$1,029 USD and \$3,905,430 Liberian Dollars
19. At the end of ULIC - 2022 National Convention that was held in Goma City, Nimba County, the amount of eight thousand (\$8,000) USD was raised toward a car for the National President, Rev. Dr. Leaid Zeyoe. The balance to be raised by the car Committee (among the Regions) by the Car Committee is five Thousand (\$5,000) Nevertheless, the vehicle was presented to the President.
